International Student Scholarships

These tuition scholarships of \$2,000 USD per year are awarded to outstanding applicants as evidenced by grades on transcripts (or mark sheets) results on national examinations, and in some cases, by SAT test results as well. **These scholarships are renewable for up to four years, and are open to first-year and transfer students.**

To be considered for an International Student Scholarship, complete the International Student Application Form and provide all the academic documents and test scores listed on the International Application Form. **No additional scholarship application form is necessary.**

We recommend candidates apply early (for example, the final deadline for fall applications is June 1st, however, students are urged to apply by April for scholarship consideration).

Ambassador Apartments World Citizen Scholarships for International Students

Two \$500 USD awards for the international students who best demonstrate an awareness and an understanding of what it means to be a world citizen today. Endowed by Frank Csapo, Ambassador Apartments. The Director of International Student Services and The International Scholarship Committee choose the recipient.

Scholars-In-Residence

These merit scholarships cover the annual costs of a shared, double room in on-campus housing (valued at approximately \$4,930 USD in 2006–2007). These scholarships are renewable for up to four years provided the recipient maintains his/her residence on-campus. If on-campus housing costs increase this scholarship award will also increase to cover the entire cost of a shared double room.

VanArsdale Scholarships

A \$1,000 USD annual award to support international students who demonstrate excellence in academics at Geneseo. Endowed by Mr. and Mrs. VanArsdale.

The Muriel A. Daniels Canadian Scholar Award

The Muriel A. Daniels Canadian Scholar Award provides a \$500 USD scholarship to an outstanding SUNY Geneseo international student with preference given to a Canadian student with a solid academic record (minimum 3.0 GPA) who demonstrates leadership, sportsmanship, respect, loyalty and integrity.

Note: Newly admitted students do **not** need to complete additional scholarship applications to be considered for the scholarships listed above.
